Free training access

We have recently been signposted to a helpful resource by the Family Support Workers at Cornwall Council, who have recommended it for **parents and carers experiencing challenging behaviour at home—particularly violence, aggression, or child-to-parent conflict.**

The shared reel (accessible via the QR code) comes from Capa First Response CIC, an organisation that provides specialist, free support for families affected by child-to-parent aggression and harmful behaviours. Capa First Response works nationally and is widely recognised for supporting parents who may feel overwhelmed, isolated or unsure where to turn.

About Capa First Response CIC

Capa First Response offers a range of accessible support options for families, including:

- Weekly online drop-ins, providing immediate advice, connection, and guidance from trained professionals.
- One-to-one tailored support, helping parents understand behaviour patterns, build confidence and use effective relational strategies at home.
- Family forums and peer groups, designed to reduce isolation and help parents learn alongside others experiencing similar challenges.
- Practical resources and podcasts that explain CAPVA and offer strategies for managing difficult moments safely and calmly.

We have been advised that this resource may be particularly useful for families who are:

- **struggling with escalating behaviour at home**
- **experiencing aggression, conflict, or unsafe situations**
- **seeking a non-judgemental space to get support and guidance**
- **feeling isolated or unsure where to access help**
